Ohio Civil Rights Transportation Symposium Scholarship 2022 Academic School Year

***UPDATED*Submission Deadline: March 14, 2022**

In celebration of the 5th Annual Ohio Civil Rights Transportation Symposium, a total of six (6) scholarships will be awarded. Three (3) scholarships of \$1,500 full-time individual students and three (3) \$500 to part-time individual students currently enrolled in a post high school education focusing in Construction or STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) related fields. The Ohio Civil Rights Transportation Symposium Scholarship focuses on broadening the number of individuals in the engineering and transportation industry.

Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible for this one-time, non-renewable **\$1,500 for 3 full-time students** and a one-time, non-renewable **\$500 for 3 part-time students** applicants must:

- Reside in Ohio; and
- Be enrolled as a full-time or part-time undergraduate in an accredited degree-granting institution; and
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 ("C+" average); and
- Be pursuing a Construction related or STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) Degree; and
- Have authorization to work in the U.S., a student authorization visa or have a DACA authorization status.

Required Documents to Submit

- Scholarship Application. A completed and signed form is required;
- Verification. Statement from a Bursar/Ombudsman staff person at your college, university or technical school confirming current enrollment;
- Transcript. Provide information that indicates current GPA;
- Resume. Provide past and current information regarding your work career and/or information about clubs and activities related to Construction, STEM or course of study;
- Essay. Your submission must not exceed a maximum 800-word typed essay, double spaced with an 11-point Arial font in an MS Word document.

Essay Topic: In your own words, please describe what outcome you predict COVID's impact will have on recruiting students and individuals with a diverse background into the transportation industry's technology and innovation field?

Completed application and all supporting documents must be received via email no later than 11:59pm on March 7, 2022. Please electronically submit all information to Lair Marin-Marcum at Lair.Marin@dot.ohio.gov. The scholarship award winners must agree to submit a photo and 15-30 second video clip that will be aired during the 5th Annual Civil Rights Transportation Symposium on April 25 – 26, 2022. Winners will be notified prior to event.
